The statement of all ongoing government and private contracts that are of a similar nature to the contract to be bid, as well as a single largest completed contract similar to the contract to be bid, shall include such contracts within three (3) years prior to the deadline for submission and receipt of bids.

II. Clarifications:

1. With regard to the audited financial statements in item 12.1(a)(v), pages 19-20 of the Bid Documents, this requirement pertains only to any audited financial statements that are submitted to IRS. This does not include all financial reports or documents of the bidder.
2. If there is a delay in the work schedule that is beyond the control of the contractor, the contract time may be extended as provided for under page 71 of the Bid Documents with the heading "Extension of Contract Time".
3. The Notarized certification stating that all equipment to be supplied is brand new and intended for the US market, as required in page 88 of the Bid Documents, shall be executed by the relevant and authorized representative of the bidder.
